


2020 PINK PRIDE ROSÉ ALEXANDER VALLEY

HARVEST & WINEMAKING NOTES

It was considered a perfect growing season for our varietals, with the reds hanging on the vine a bit longer, developing greater complexity. Of much concern and a common question from this harvest is whether we were affected by smoke taint. Although there is much to learn about taint, the risk is directly correlated with the stage of a vine's growth and development. The period between veraison and harvest is when grapes are most susceptible and we were well into harvest with most of our fruit beginning fermentation in stainless steel tanks and what had not been harvested showed no signs of flaw. For many reasons, 2020 will go down in history as one of the most memorable harvests of all time. The resilience of our earth and the food it produces gives us inspiration and hope. Regardless of the obstacles, the fruit was absolute and stood its ground against all odds. The final product is outstanding and we are incredibly grateful!
